- But, more importantly to identify what to do about it and the order of priority.

- Siga was involved in site meetings with various parties to determine the sources of concern, comment on the severity of the concerns and recommend remedial works.
- Structural reports documenting the above were produced as well as site inspections of the works during repairs, and subsequent certification.
